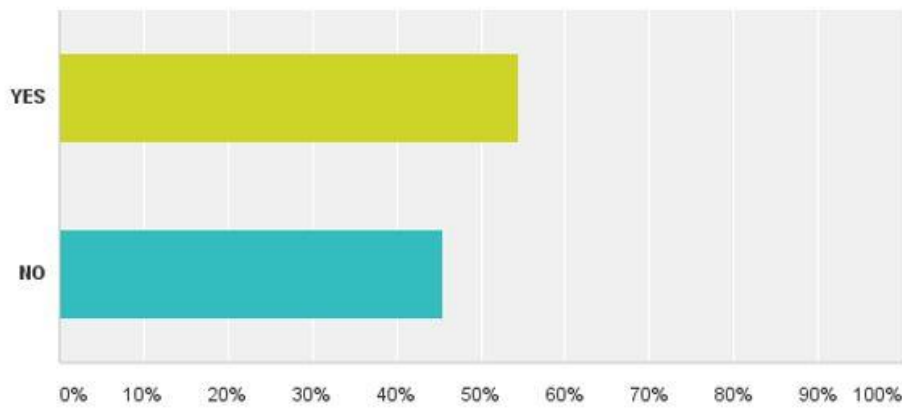


## March 2017 Survey Results

Over 1400 people responded

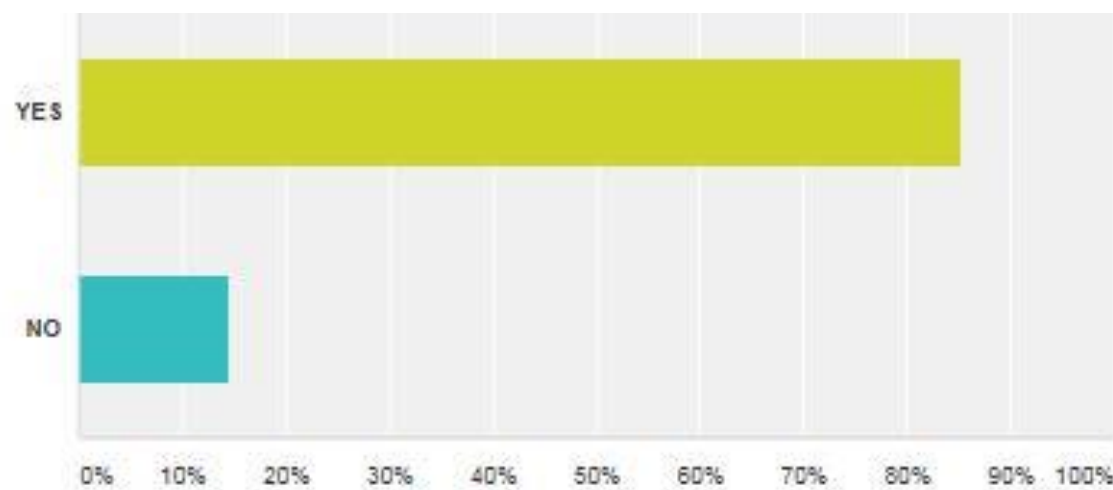
**Q1: Affordable homes for younger people and families.** You told us you wanted more affordable homes but research tells us we need to build even more homes than New Forest District Council suggest if we want to meet the housing needs of younger people and families. Would you support the development of more than 930 homes, if it would enable more affordable homes to be built?



**YES: 54.5%**

**NO: 45.5%**

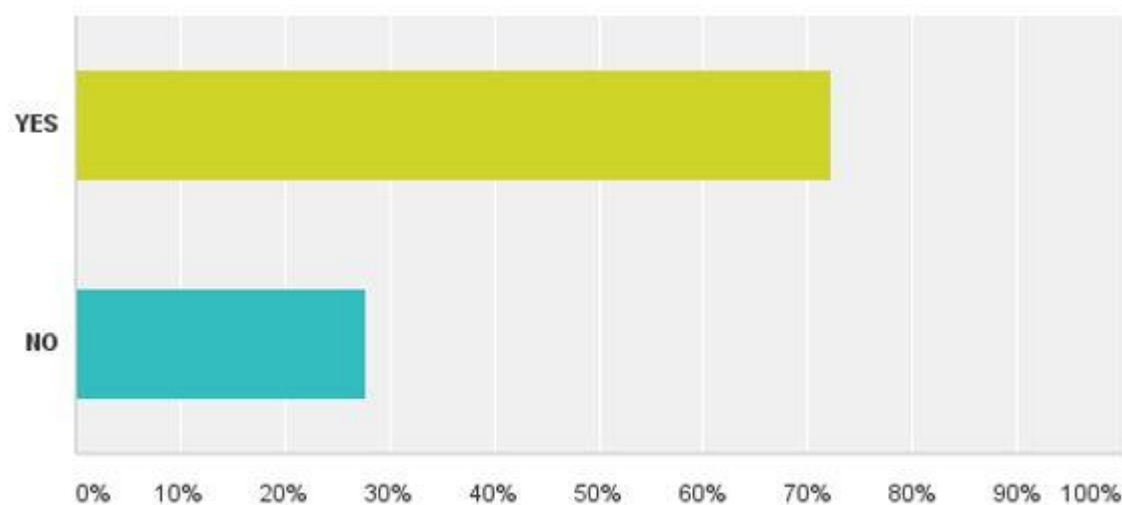
**Q2: Creating an attractive and vibrant Town Centre.** We want to improve the vibrancy of the Town Centre. This might involve improving access to the Station, resolving traffic issues at Ashley Road and increasing the number of homes in the Town Centre to achieve a balanced mix of residential, shops and services. If we are to limit the use of Green Belt land around the town to build more affordable housing, more residential development within the Town Centre area will be needed. Would you support a regeneration of the Town Centre that included some residential development to reduce the amount of building on Green Belt land?



**YES: 85.35%**

**NO: 14.65%**

**Q3: Locations for new homes and employment.** There are few options available to us even with some additional residential development in the Town Centre. The locations for new homes are based on recent information that less land is now available between Gore Road and Christchurch Road. There is not enough space in the Town Centre to offset this, but there may be the opportunity for more homes on land between Stem Lane and Gore Road (Site K). Would you support the Neighbourhood Plan assessing how this land could be used and how many homes it could accommodate?
